The Putnam County Board of Commissioners and Council met on September 16, 2025, at 8:15 PM in joint session. The meeting was held at the courthouse in the Commissioners meeting room.

NEW LOCATION FOR THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT (BUILDING)

Woodall said the health department must move out of the hospital. Two options the county has been looking at is 1275 N Jackson St. and 309 Medic Way. Entertained any questions from the audience. No questions. There were two appraisals for both buildings. The county cannot pay any more than the average of the two appraisals.

The Commissioners and Council need to decide which building they wish to pursue. Beck made the motion to make the recommendation of 309 Medic Way. Helmer seconded. The motion passed unanimously. The Council in a consensus agreed unanimously. Commissioners will proceed with the hospital board to purchase. Once they have an agreement they will come before the council to request funding.

PROCLAMATION CONCERNING FIRE HAZARDS

Sheriff Baugh said if it was a fire that was set illegally the police would come and site the offender.
