The Putnam County Board of Commissioners met in Regular Session on December 6, 2021 at 9:00 AM at the Putnam County Courthouse. Rick Woodall opened the meeting and the pledge to the flag was given.

General discussion was made on the annual Commissioners Conference. Rick Woodall stated there were several ARPA meetings held.

## **ELECTION REDISTRICTING**

No representation from the Clerk. Rick Woodall stated most of the redistricting was within the City of Greencastle.

## **PLANNING & ZONING**
